From the knitting needles of Mrs. Saint Nick



<u>Knitted Bookmarks.</u>

You'll need a thin weight cotton yarn (perhaps you have some leftover balls around) and small enough needles to make tight stitches.

Cast on ten stitches.

Row 1, knit five, purl five.

Repeat for six rows.

Row 7, purl five, knit five.


Repeat for six rows.

Repeat the first 12 rows as many times as needed for your desired length.

Bind off. Weave in ends. Then loop loose yarn through one end to make the bookmark's tail.



You can whip these up in no time at all.
