From the knitting needles of Mrs. Saint Nick




Christmas Bells



You will need Holiday colored yarn in a worsted weight Knitting needles—anything between a 6 and a 9 that will give you a fairly tight stitch. Too loose and the bell won't hold its shape. Yarn needle

Cast on fourteen stitches. Leaving about a ten inch tail. Row 1—knit across Row 2—purl four, knit ten Repeat rows 1 and 2 until you have 22 rows. Bind off, leaving another ten inch tail.

Stitch cast-on and bound-off sides together. Using your needle and tail of the thread away from the ribbing, pick up stitches and draw tight. Use that thread to make a loop for hanging. If desired, attach a small bell inside.
