Supplies

Styrofoam circle—I used an old straw wreath that had seen its better days.

I inch wide fabric strips, as long as need to easily tie them with a double knot. I cut mine with a pinking rotary cutter. Ribbon for the bow

Directions


Cut your fabric strips out of Christmas colored fabrics. A pinking rotary cutter makes this goes very fast. Because I used old scraps, I can't tell you how much yardage you'll need. The amount you'll use also depends on whether you want it to be fat with scraps or thinner. However much you use, you'll be pleasantly pleased with the results.

Tie each fabric around your circle in a double knot, making sure to cover your circle. Tie Ribbon on when you are happy with the look of the wreath.

It doesn't take long to make the door-sized wreath o this decoration using ½ inch wide scraps tied around a curtain ring.



Big or small, these wreaths make great gifts for friends and any hostess of a December Party.
